  - ▶ 350K fatalities in the last 10 years
  - ▶ 1 fatality in the last 10 years (SW Airline engine failure)

# UPSTREAM AND MIDSTREAM VEHICLE PERFORMANCE

## 2018-2019

1/12/2018	An Apache vehicle sustained damage when it struck a third party vehicle from behind at an intersection.
1/15/2018	Employee struck a pole mounted fire extinguisher ( <b>fixed object</b> ) at the King Hidalgo CPF <b>while backing</b> .
4/26/2018	<b>While leaving</b> the Cedar 101AH, an Apache employee struck a cattle guard gate with his vehicle, resulting in property damage
5/25/2018	While traveling back to San Antonio from Midland, TX, an Apache employee struck a third party vehicle (Enate Inc.) from behind, resulting in minor damage.
6/27/2018	Employee struck a light pole ( <b>fixed object</b> ) at the Redwood CPF <b>while backing</b> .
7/16/2018	An Apache employee struck a fire hydrant ( <b>fixed object</b> ) <b>while pulling forward</b> , and turning right out of a residential driveway.
7/19/2018	<b>While leaving location</b> , an Apache employee ran over a 7-1/16 wellhead spool, resulting in damage to the vehicle.
7/26/2018	<b>While turning into the man camp</b> , an Apache employee struck the key pad post, resulting in damage to his vehicle.

8/2/2018	<b>While backing</b> out of a convenience store parking lot, an Apache vehicle impacted a third party vehicle, resulting in damage.
8/9/2018	<b>While leaving</b> a tank battery location, an Apache employee inadvertently struck a conduit riser, resulting in damage to the vehicle.
8/24/2018	Apache employee struck <b>fixed light pole</b> with a service truck <b>while traveling forward</b> at Redwood CPF.
8/27/2018	While traveling back to San Antonio (SA) from Pecos, TX an Apache employee struck a third party vehicle in the rear driver quarter panel, resulting in minor damage.
10/22/2018	<b>While traveling on a lease road</b> , an Apache employee stopped, reversed and struck a contract vehicle traveling behind him.
12/10/2018	<b>While pulling into</b> the Promenade II lower level parking garage, the Apache employee struck a concrete bollard protecting the badge-in device.
1/5/2019	<b>While backing out</b> of his driveway, an employee <b>struck a pole</b> with his vehicle, resulting in damage.
