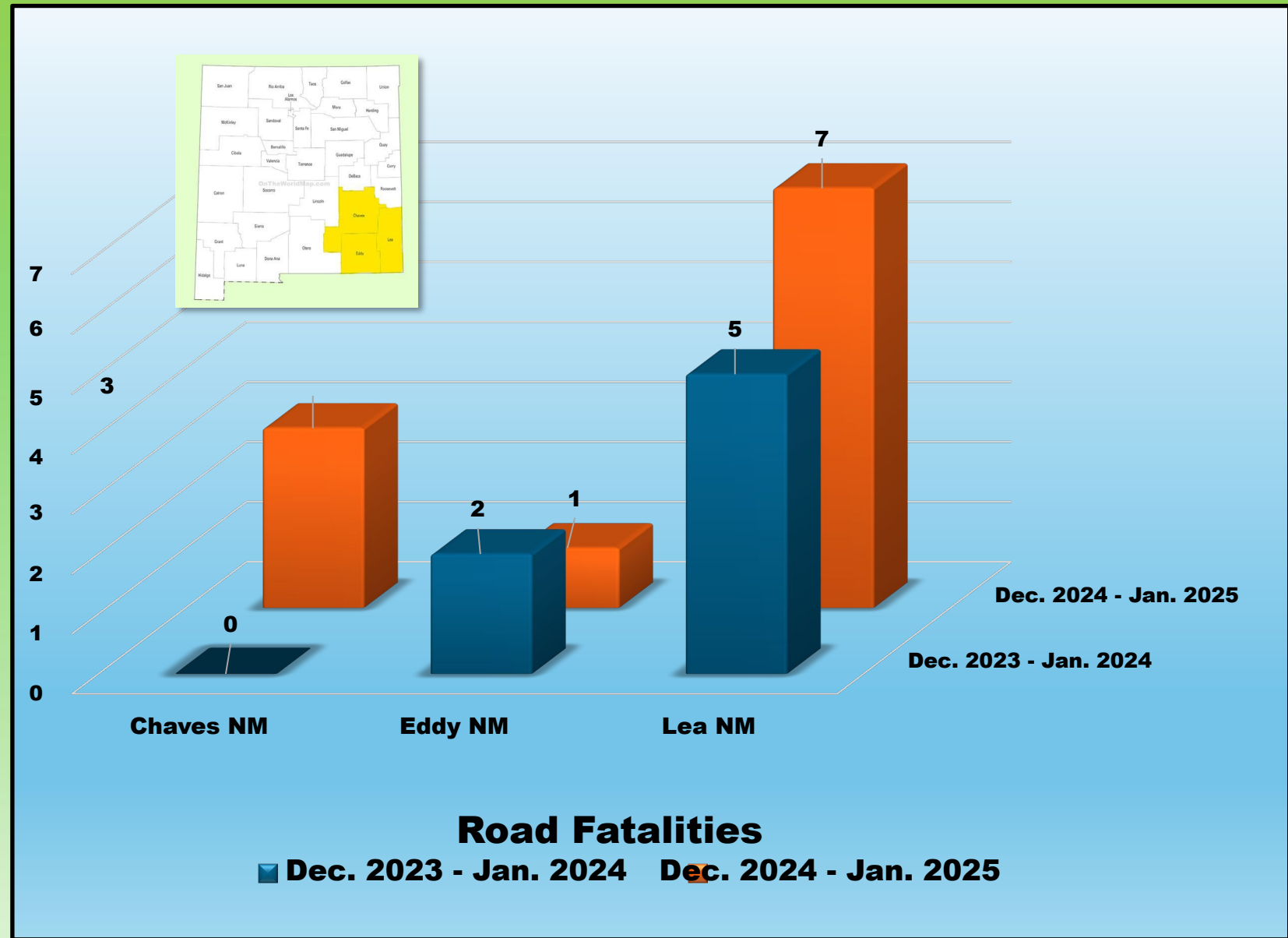

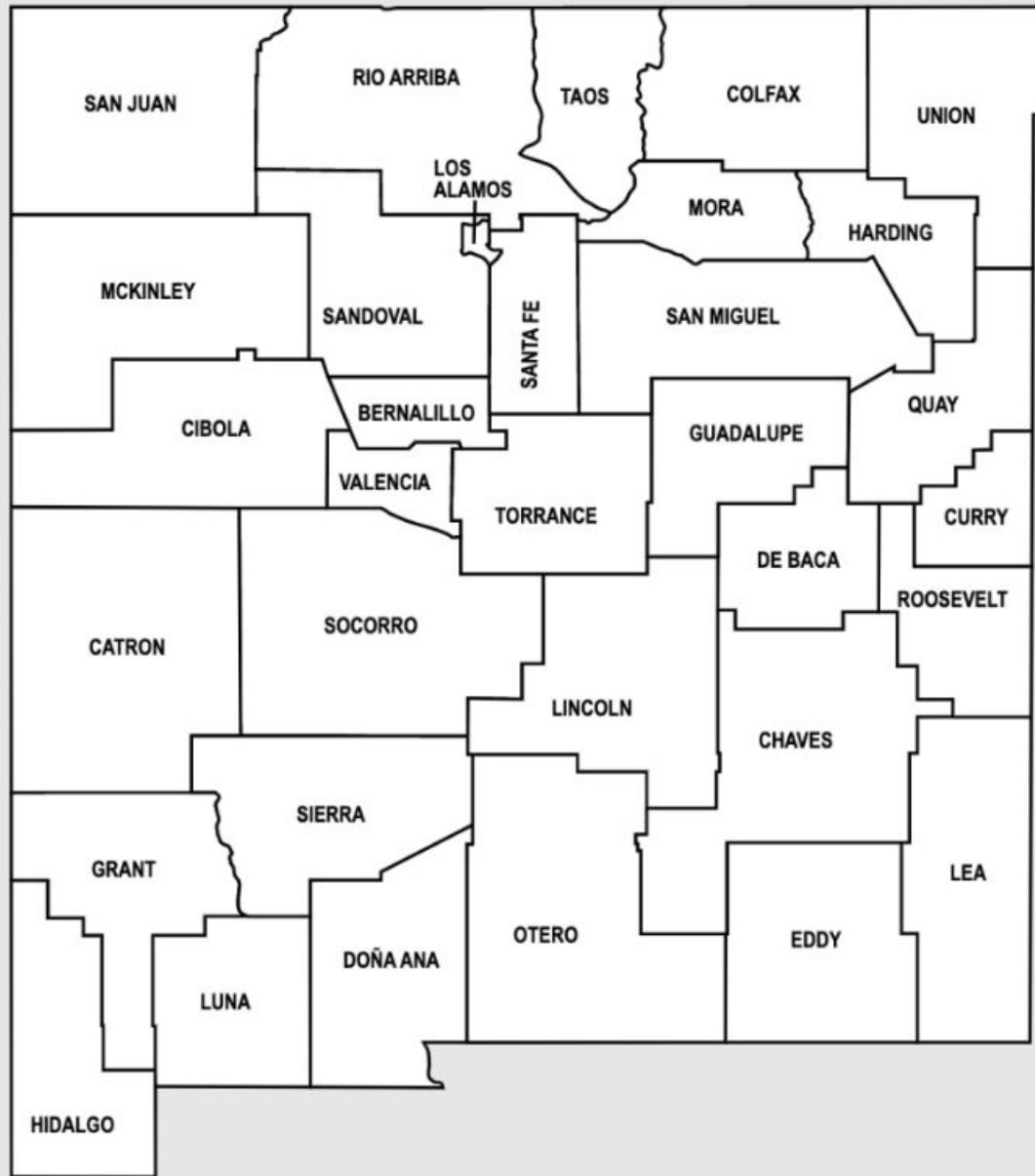

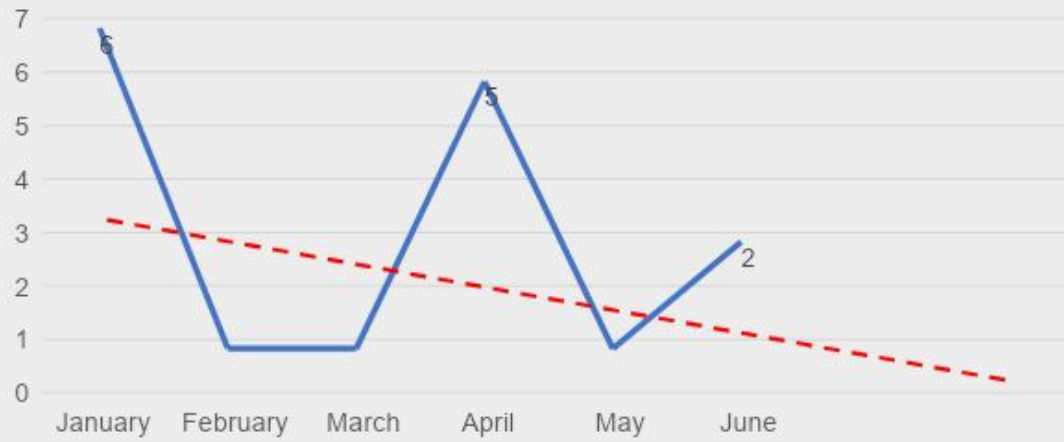
March to Safety

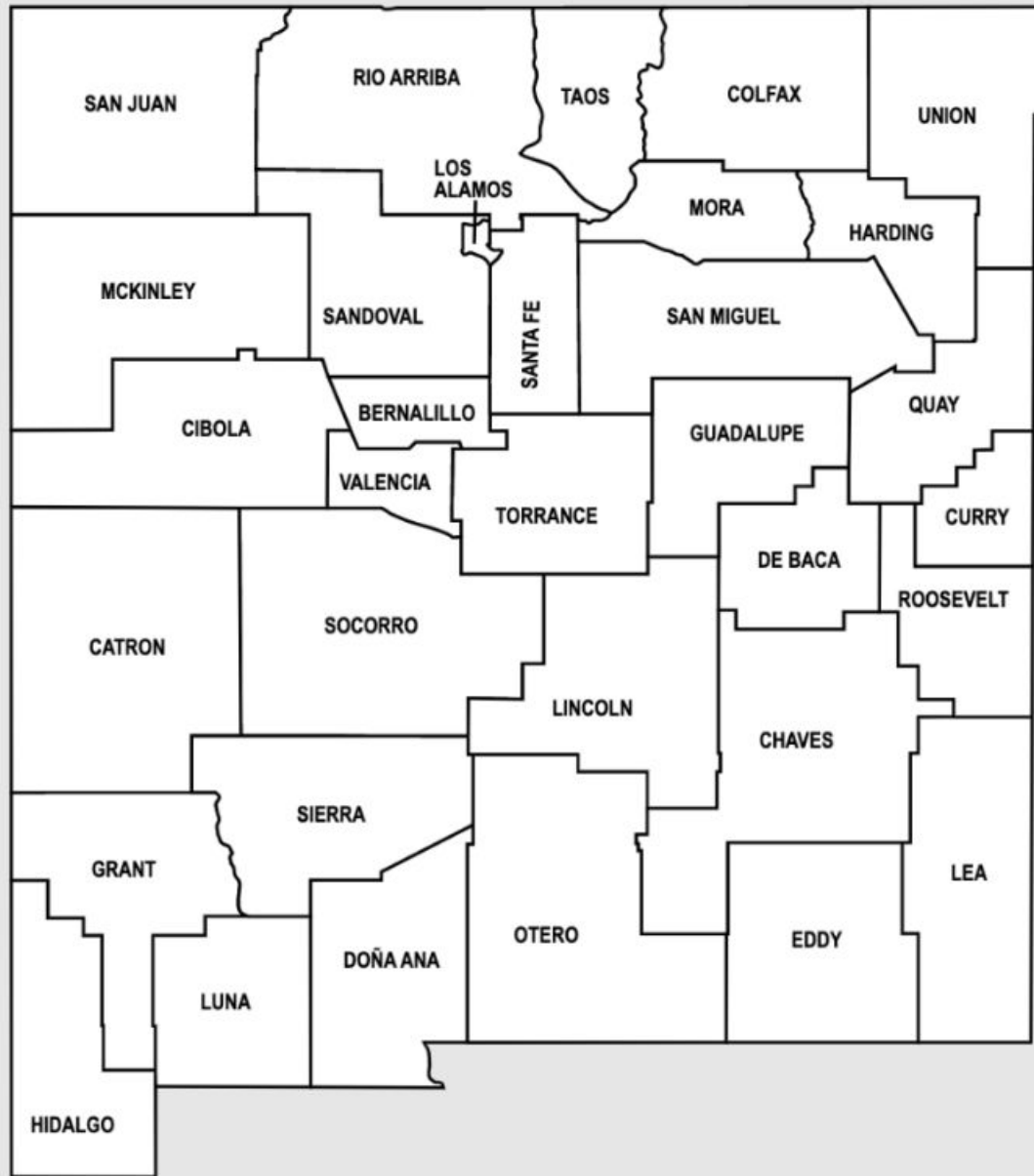

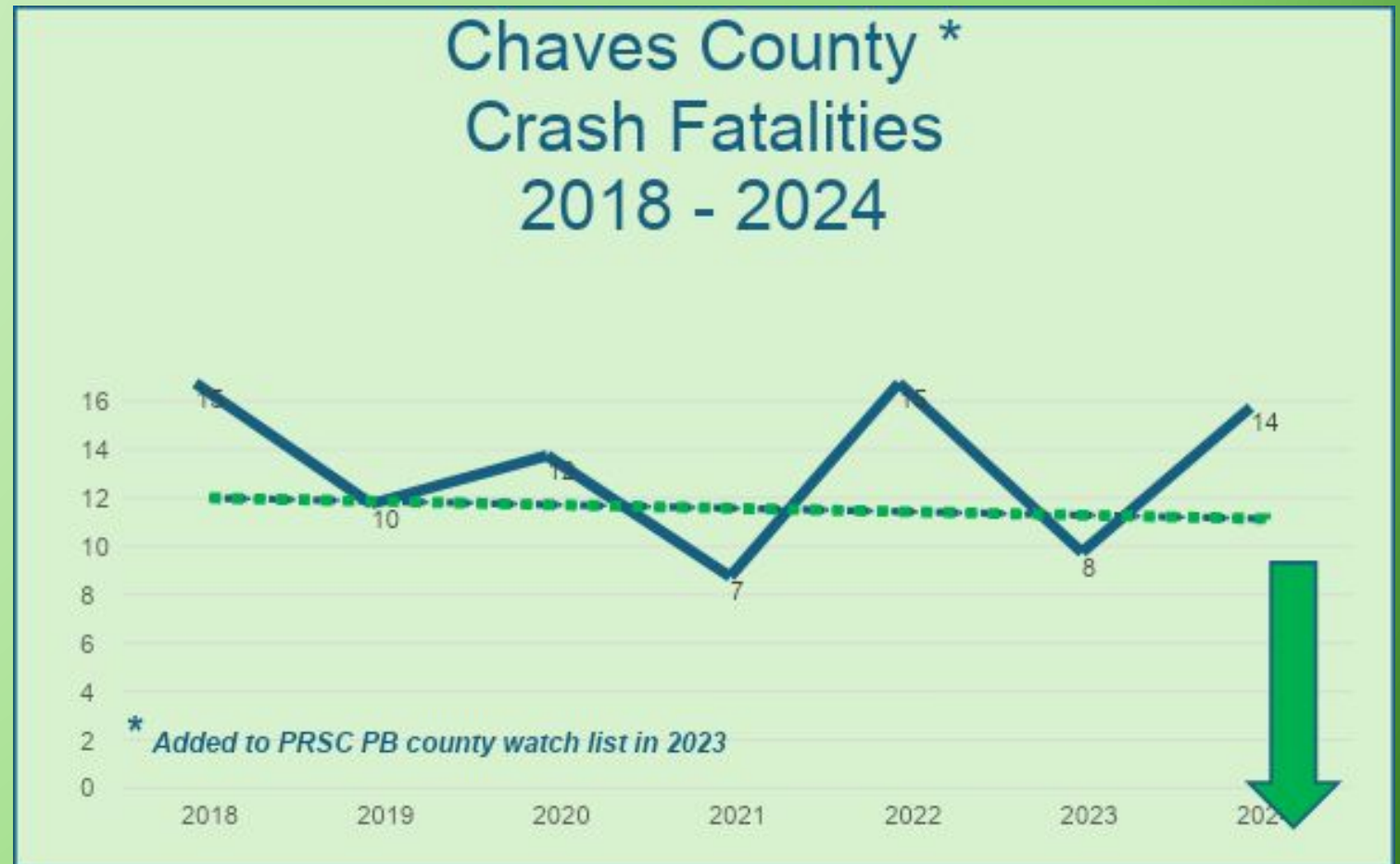

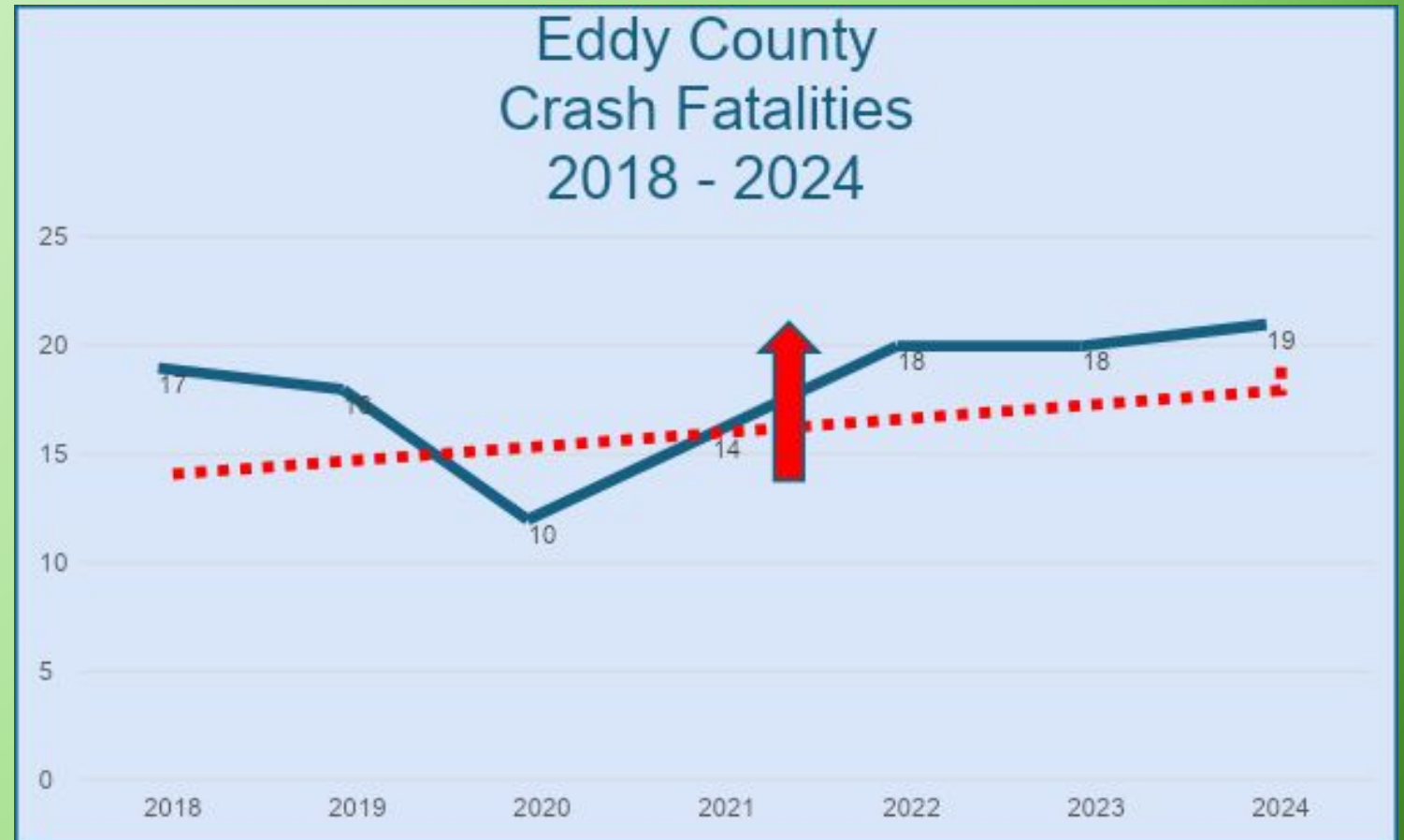
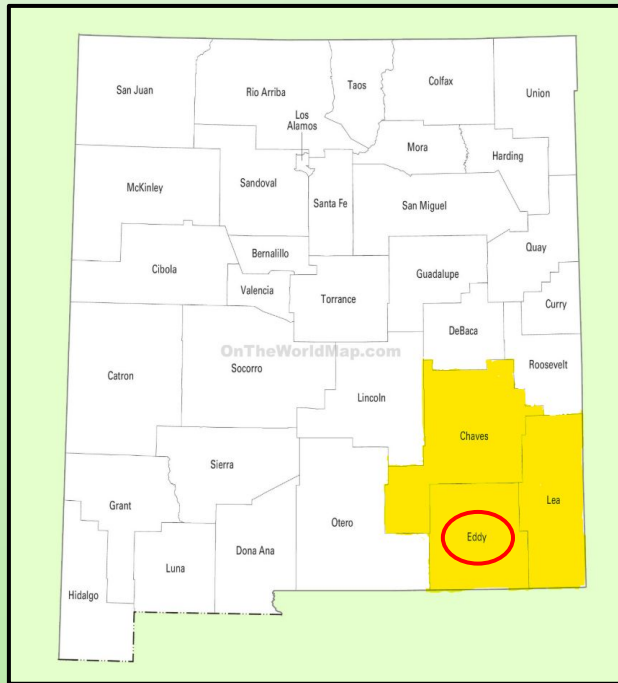
New Mexico Data 2018-2024



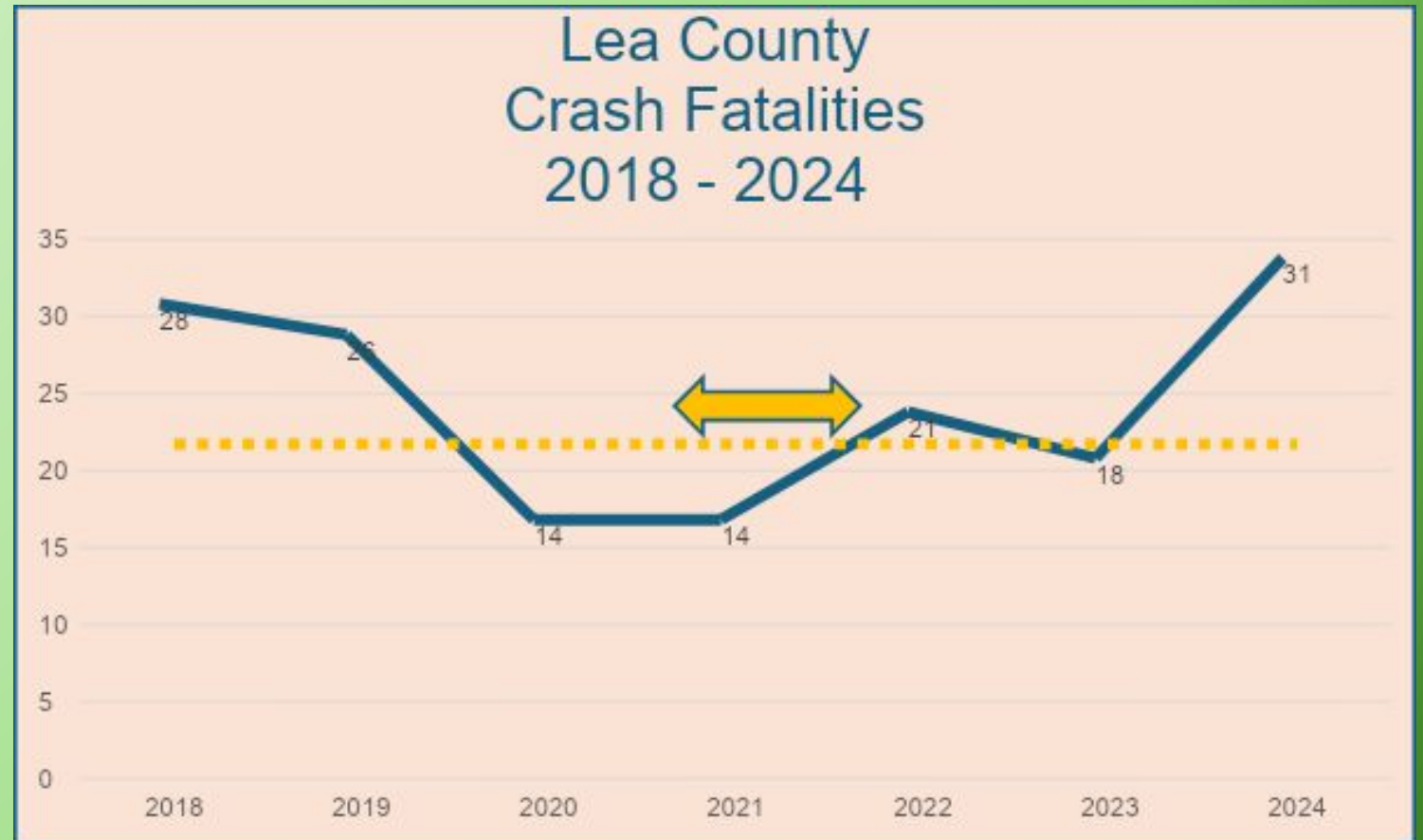
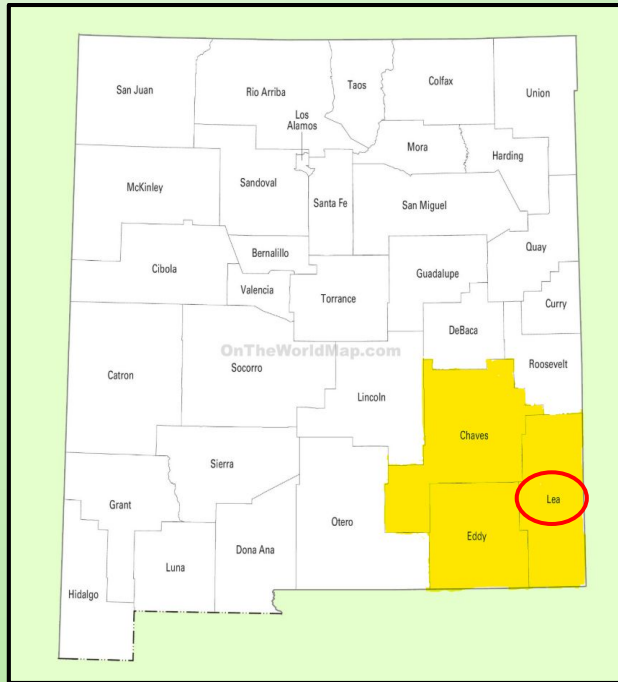
PRSC progress over seven years promoting road safety in Chaves County, NM
